SeniorCare Experts is that *first call* when you know help may be needed. As many seniors are on a fixed income, often times there is a hardship to acquire such services that they very much need. We do not ever want to turn someone away. When we know that this senior needs this service, we will subsidize those costs in order to preserve their health and wellbeing.

What is the criteria for each nominee?

There are nomination forms for the honorees. A brief description of qualifications are:

Ambassador for Seniors: This candidate is someone who speaks up for seniors, some that may not be capable of speaking for themselves; or speaking up for a cause that affects the welfare of a senior(s). This could be a family member, friend, volunteer and or a professional.

How does SeniorCare Experts help?

We focus on what the individual needs. We can offer a variety of services that seniors and their families can pick from that will best fit the need of the individual. If the individual requires assistance in an area that is not under our umbrella of services, we have many partners in the community that we will recommend.

- **Consultations, Assessments, Information and Referrals:** We offer free assessments to help the senior and his/her family members know what is best for the individual. Many times people just need a little help walking this journey. We can consult over the phone or meet with the family in the comfort of their home.
- **Home Delivered Chef Prepared Meals:** Seniors enjoy a freshly prepared meal each weekday. We have wonderful volunteers who deliver the meals. These volunteers also serve as another set of eyes ensuring the safety of the individual. The senior not only receives a wonderful meal, they enjoy a visit from the caring volunteer as well.
- **Emergency Medical Alert** is a 24/7 service giving the senior an extra level of safety in the home. The senior can press a waterproof button to call for help to the nearest relative/neighbor, friend or EMS (if needed). The fall sensor button is designed to activate the alert if the person falls and is not able to push the button. There are many choices depending on the individual's needs including a GPS option. We offer contract-free full service utilizing Guardian Medical Monitoring.
- **Prescription Medication Dispenser:** This is an in-home system that helps manage the complex medication regime seniors often face. The monitored dispenser prevents the senior from common mistakes such as taking doses at the wrong time or taking incorrect amounts. If the senior misses taking a dose at a designated time, the system contacts the caregiver which provides a complete loop of protection for the senior.
- **Home Care/Respite:** We help seniors if there is a need for personal care, light chores, light meal preparation, bathing/grooming, transportation and companionship. This service relieves the caregiver so they have quality time for themselves.
- **Escorted Transportation:** This is a door thru door service. Volunteers drive senior clients to the doctor, grocery, short personal errands; visit a friend or even the beauty/barber shop.
- **Desk Mates:** We provide personal assistance with basic financial and household tasks such as organizing records, sorting mail, making sure bills are getting paid on time and helping avoid financial scams.
